Visit to Feering and Kelvedon Local History Museum
and to Wilkin & Sons Ltd Jam Factory Museum, Tiptree

Wednesday 1st May 2024



Today we are visiting the Feering and Kelvedon Local History Museum formed in 1975 in a building shared with the library and erected c.1630. The building and collection are modest in size but contain fascinating material related to village life including Roman artefacts and 19th and 20th Century bygones. There is also a note of Kelvedon's most famous son: Charles Haddon Spurgeon. Please meet in the car park at 10.55 a.m. to meet our guide(s). The library is closed on the day of our visit and there are NO public toilets on the site in Maldon Road, Kelvedon (CO5 9BA).

Members attending may choose to find a local pub or coffee shop for lunch or to go direct to Wilkin's Jam Factory at Tiptree. If a sufficient number of Friends wishes to attend, then it may be possible to book the marquee adjacent to the Museum. From 2.00 p.m. friend of the Friends Nick Wickenden, now consultant to the Factory Museum, will show us the displays and tell us of the history of the collection of machinery, ephemera and records started by Mr. J.S. Wilkin. With Nick, we can be sure of a lively and informative visit. The site is on Brook Road, Tiptree, CO5 0RF.
