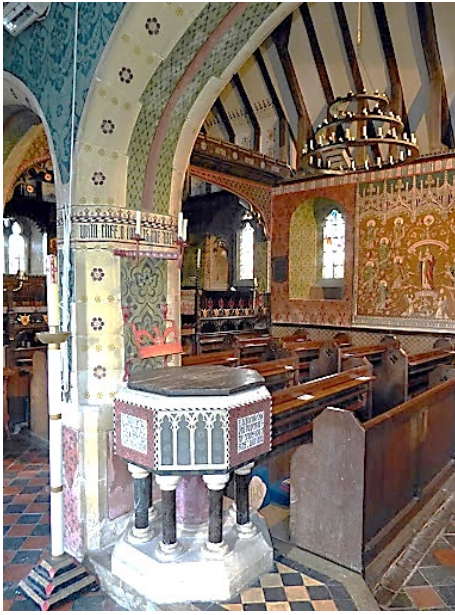


**FCM Visit to St Nicholas Church, Little Braxted CM8 3EU

Little Braxted Church is a small Norman building with a semicircular apse and one original window. In 1881 the rector believed that ‘God’s house ought to be the finest...and...most beautiful house in a parish’ and the interior is much as the Rev Ernest Geldart left it. Details with regard to parking etc to follow nearer the date. This visit starts at 11am.

After lunch we meet at 2.00pm at Kelvedon Hall garden. This is a varied six-acre garden surrounding a splendid C18th house. There are formal and informal spaces as well as a courtyard walled garden and a modern pool garden. Home-made teas will be provided.
